High School Equivalency Diploma Pathways

AWC Parker offers three pathways to obtain your High School Diploma Equivalency (HSE). Meet with an advisor to determine what is the best option for you.

College Credit Pathway (CCP)

Students can earn their HSE Diploma by demonstrating completion of 25 specific college credits along with passing the AZ Civics Test. This pathway allows individuals to engage in coursework that will be relevant to completing a degree or training pathway post high school equivalency.

HSE PLUS Career Readiness Pathway**

Through this pathway, candidates can use a variety of options to earn the required points to be eligible for an HSE Diploma. Individuals can earn their HSE Diploma by demonstrating Academic Readiness (14 points) and Career Readiness (8 points) for a required total of 22 points.

GED Testing Pathway**

The GED Pathway is comprised of passing 5 tests to earn the HSE Diploma: Reasoning Through Language Arts, Mathematical Reasoning, Science, Social Studies, and Arizona Civics. We offer Adult Basic Education (ABE) classes to prepare individuals for each of the tests.

Eligibility for programs:

- ◆ Must be 16 years old or older
- ◆ Not enrolled in secondary school or required to be enrolled in secondary school
- ◆ Lack a High School Diploma

Additional Requirements (**GED**) for 16 and 17 year old individuals: Must be completed prior to scheduling testing.

1. Must create test-taker profile
2. Must present the following documentation
 - a. Official withdrawal from the last school attended.
 - b. Notarized and dated permission letter from a parent or guardian.

*Additional pathway requirements may be needed.

** These 8-week long classes may be considered towards completion of both pathways.
