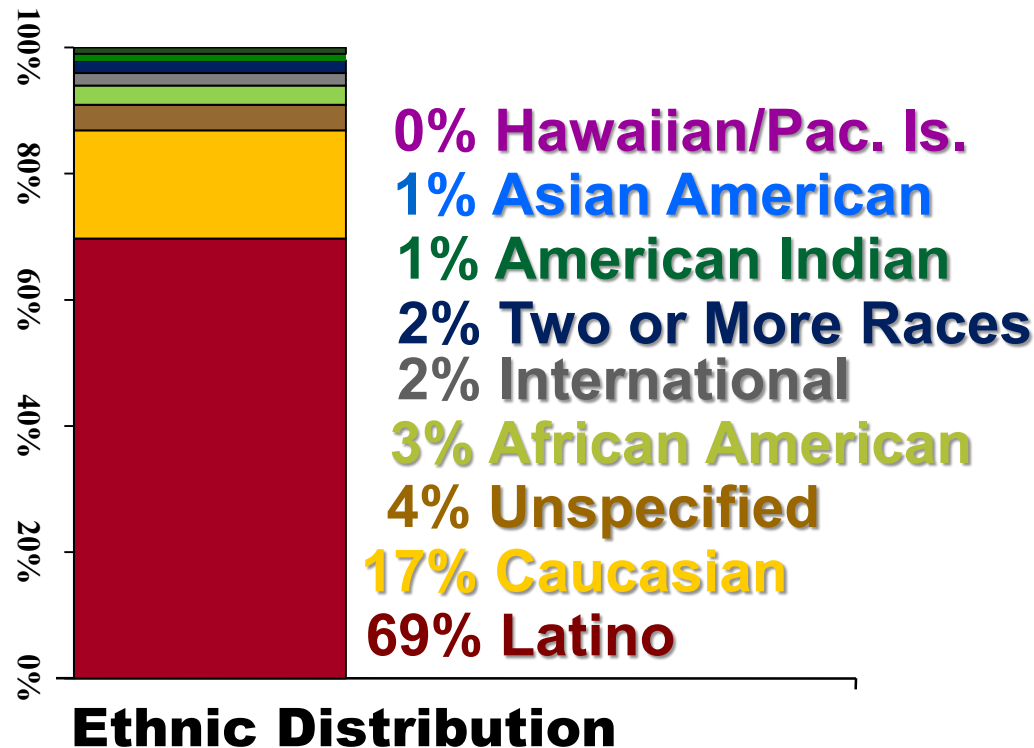

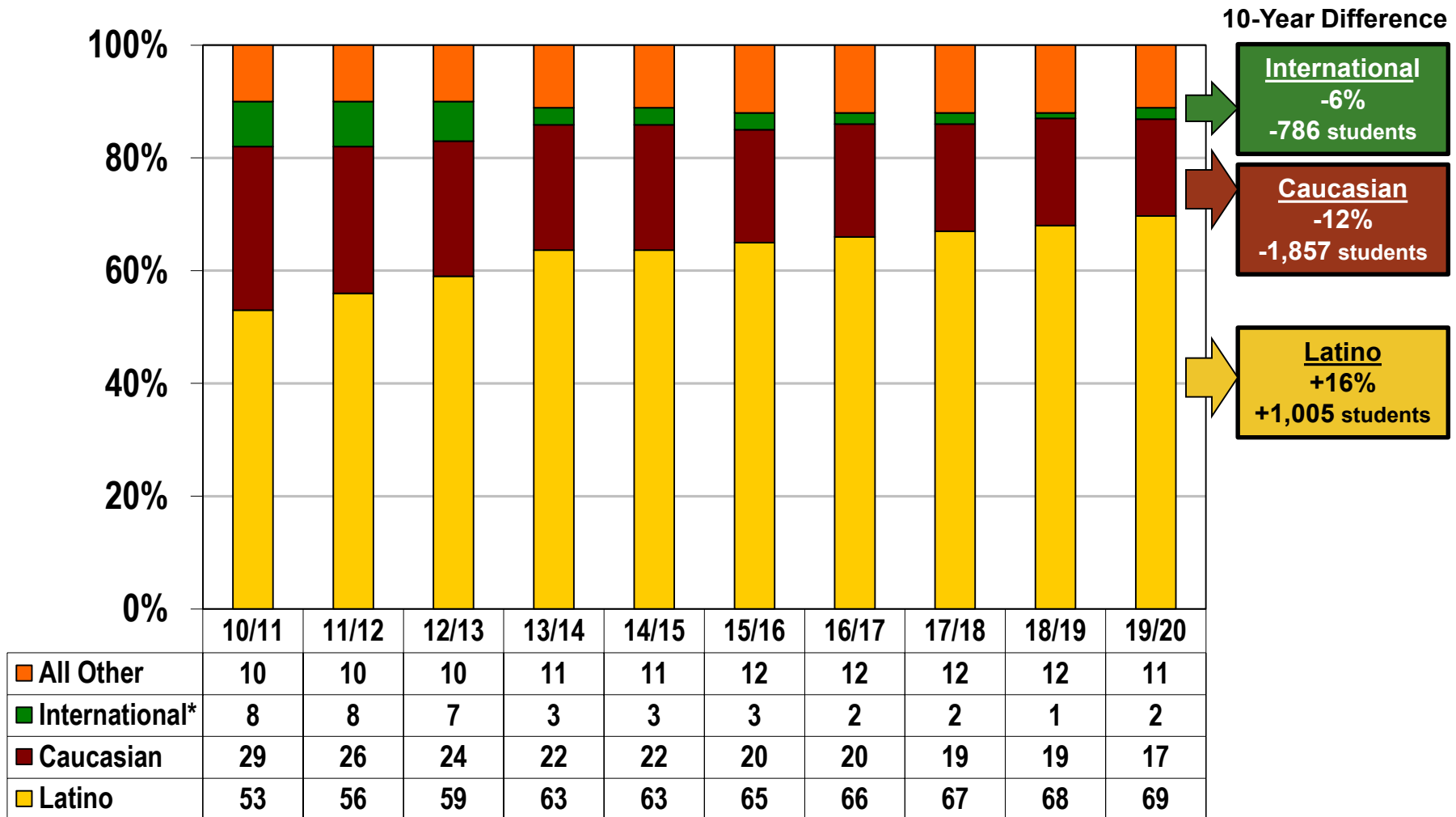

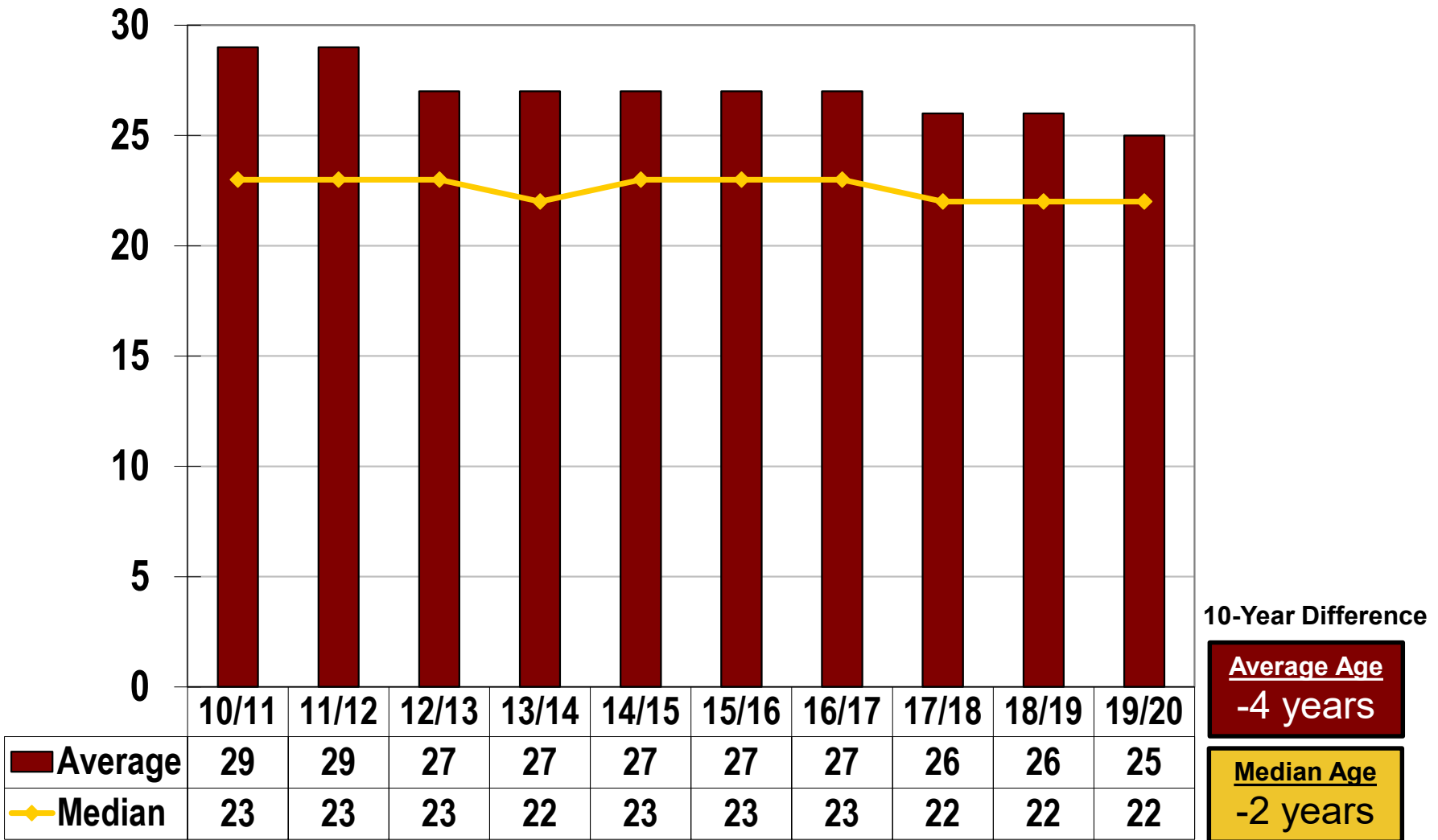
Trend of Enrollment by Ethnicity

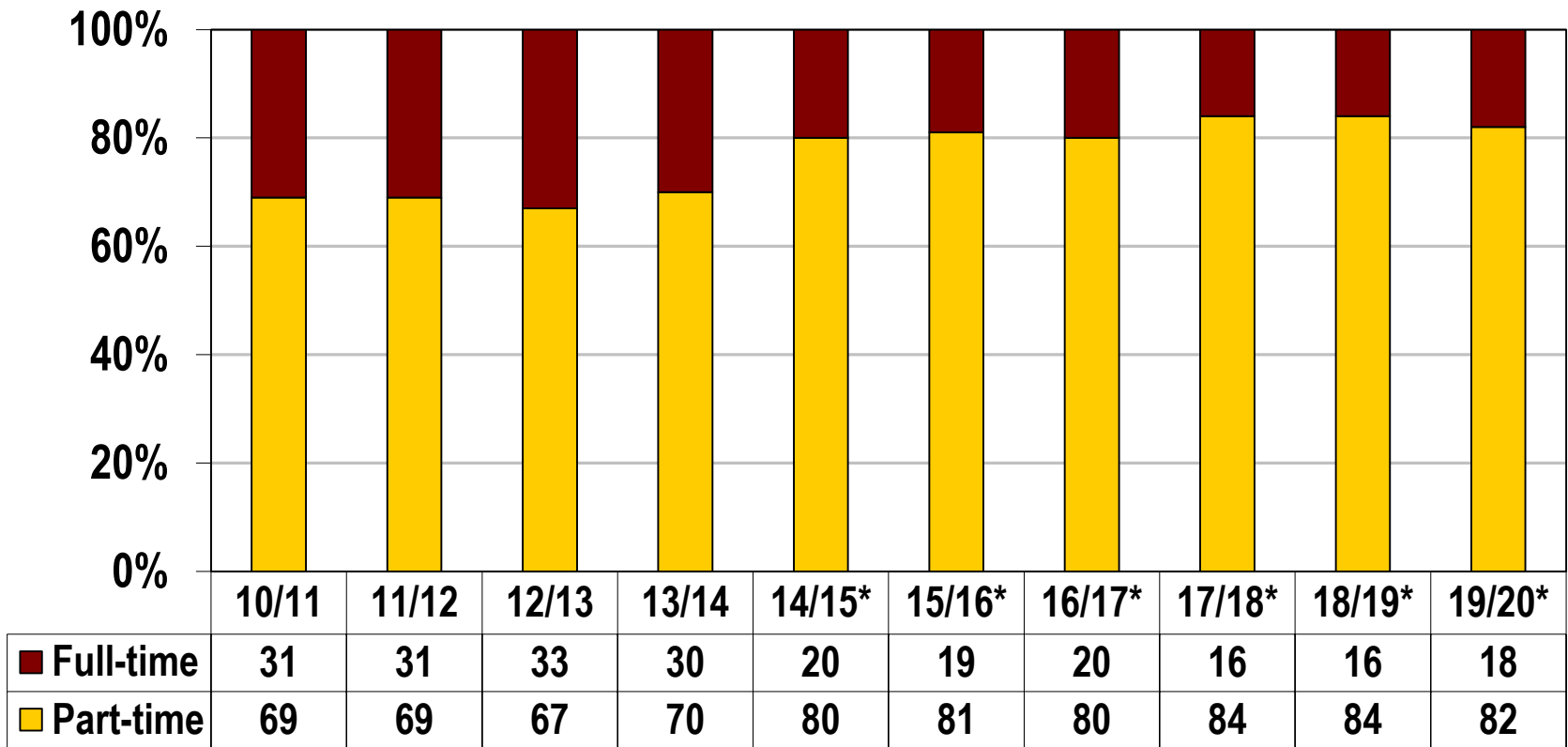

Trend of Enrollment by Attendance

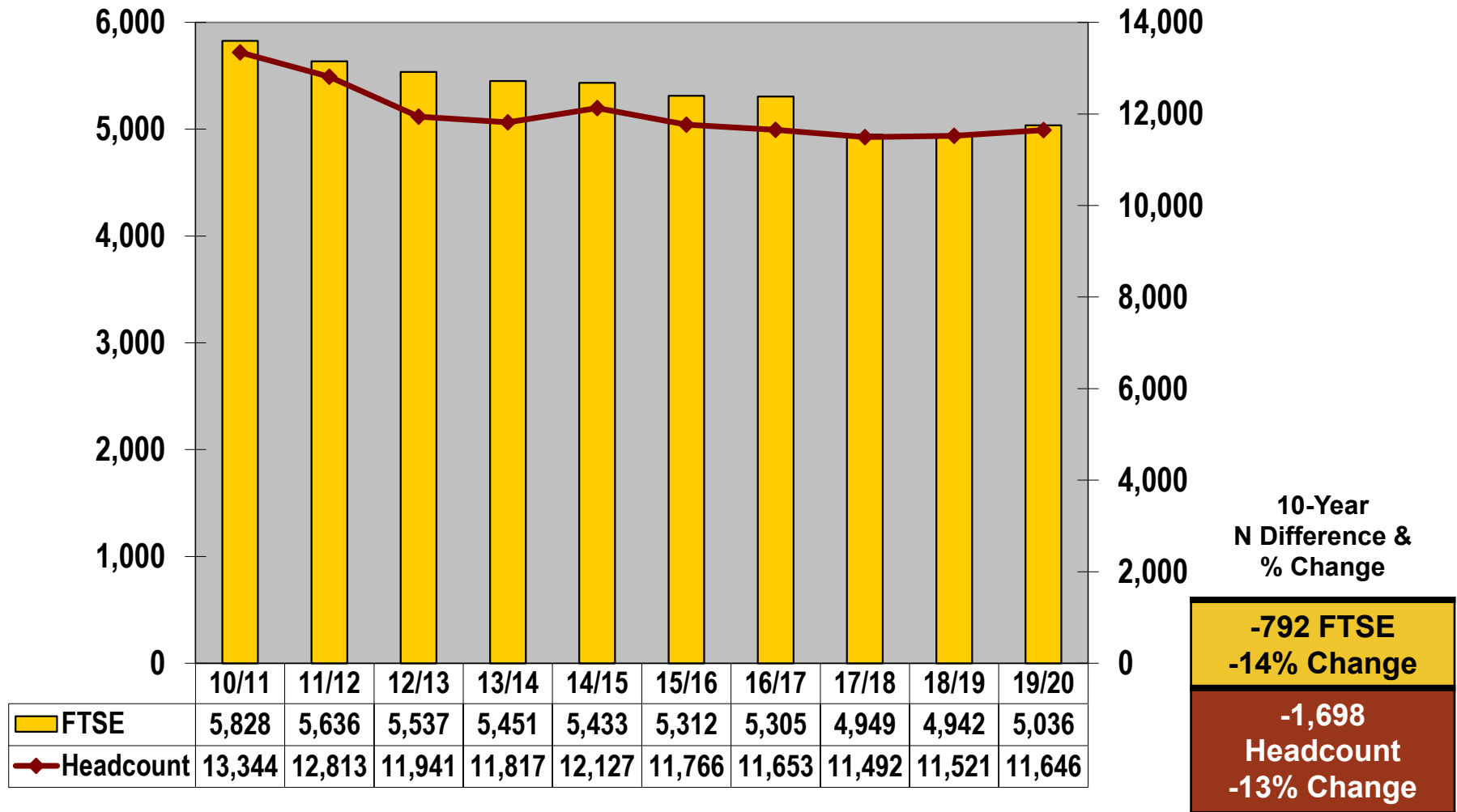


Despite predominance of traditional college-age students, most attend part-time.

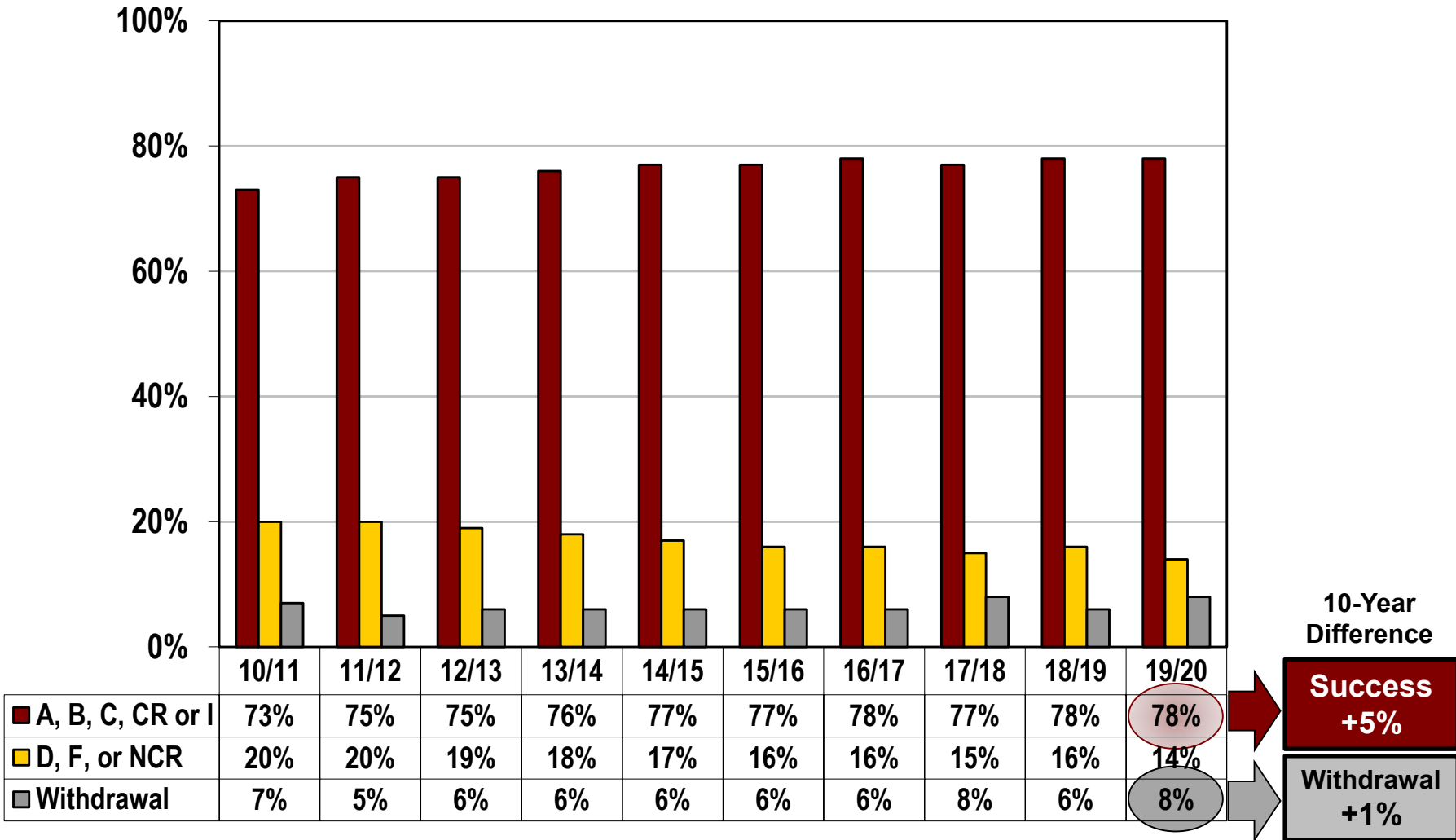
Annualized Full-Time Student Equivalent (FTSE) and Unduplicated Student Headcount

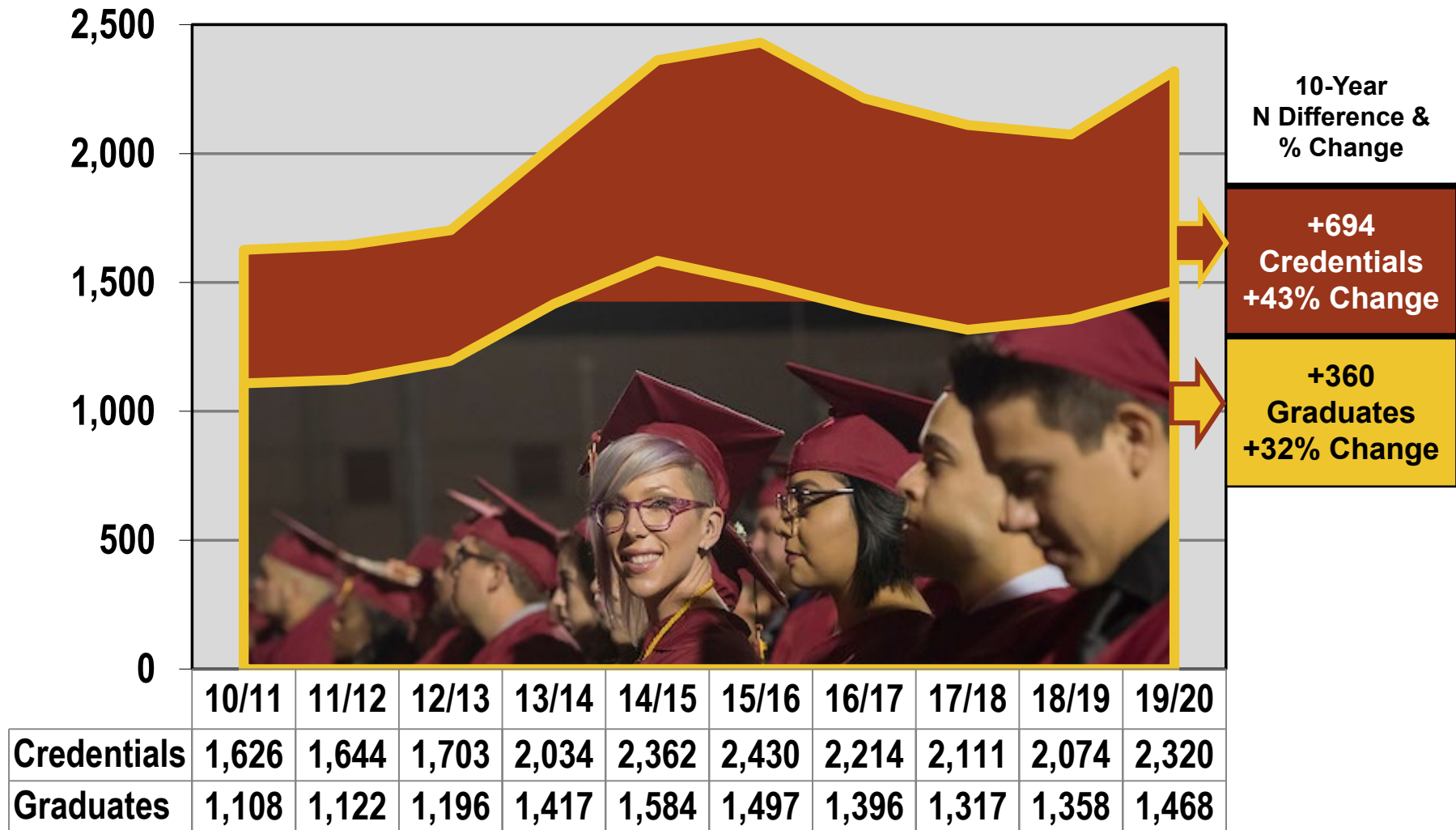
Trend of Academic Success and Withdrawals

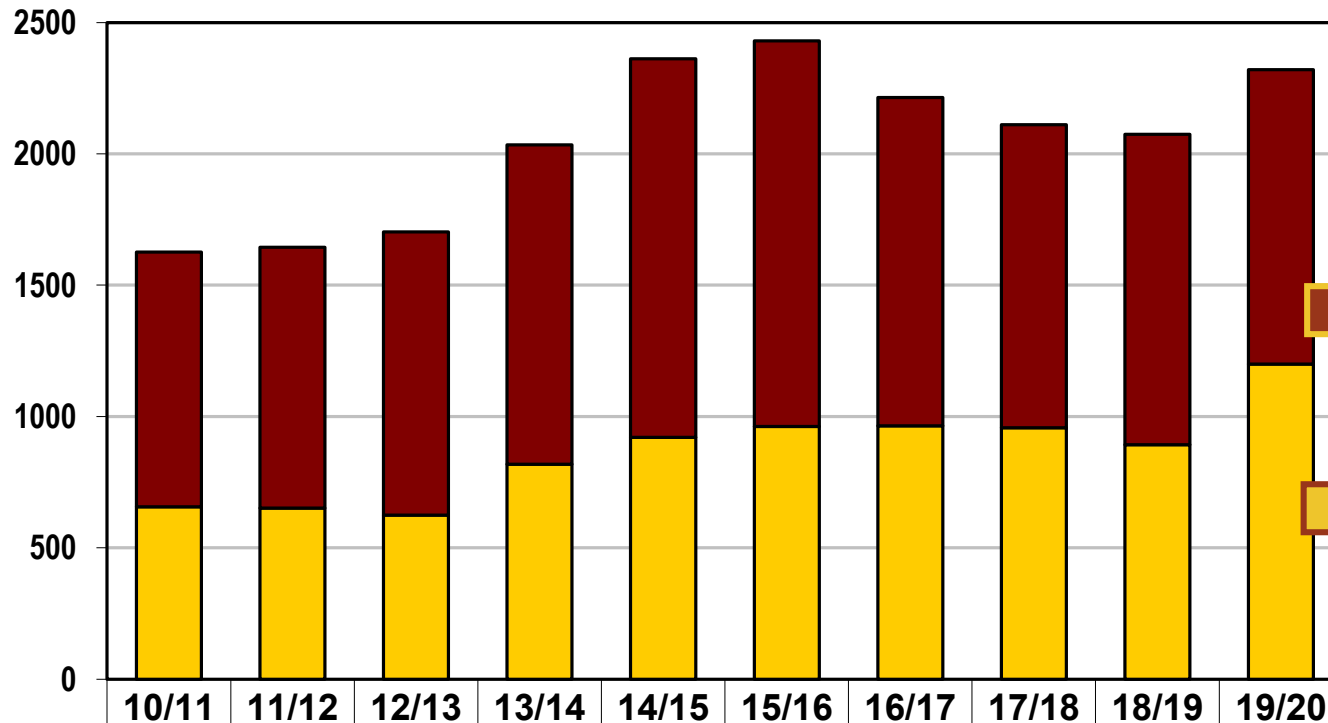


Trend of Credentials Awarded and Graduates
