Review any evidence "directly related to the allegations," including the evidence upon which the recipient does not intend to rely in reaching a determination regarding responsibility and inculpatory or exculpatory evidence whether obtained from a party or other source - 106.45(b)(5)(vi)



*Prior to completion of the investigative report,* the recipient must send to each party...the evidence subject to inspection and review [this refers to the evidence in the green section above]...and the parties must have at least 10 days to submit a written response, which the investigator will consider *prior to completion of the investigative report* - 106.45(b)(5)(vi)
