PRIVILEGE LOG

A privilege log is a list of documents the investigators/parties in a case believe are privileged and protected against disclosure in a Title IX Case.

The party seeking protection from disclosure has the burden of proving that the materials are legally privileged.

Types of Privilege (§ 106.45(b)(5)(i)):

- 1. **Redact information:** Information that is not directly related to the allegations or that is otherwise barred from use, such as because of a legally-recognized and unwaived privilege. (e.g., FERPA protected information, attorney-client privilege).
- 2. **Treatment Records:** Records made or maintained by a physician, psychiatrist, psychologist, or other recognized professional or paraprofessional acting in the professional's or paraprofessional's capacity, or assisting in that capacity, and which are made and maintained in connection with the provision of treatment to the party, unless the Title IX Coordinator obtains that party's voluntary, written consent to do so for a grievance process under this section 3. **Privacy Laws:** Right to privacy under the Constitution or any law enacted by the government.
