Section:	Administration	Subject:	Bicycles and Skateboards on Arizona Western College Property

PURPOSE

To regulate the use of bicycles, skateboards, tricycles, unicycles scooters, roller skates, in-line skates and all other non-motorized wheeled conveyances on district wide college property.

To regulate the use of battery charged/motorized self-propelled conveyances to include but not limited to hoverboards and motorized skateboards.

PROCEDURE

1. No person shall operate a vehicle covered by this procedure upon a walkway less than four feet in width, on the stairways, access ramps or beneath the overhang of any college structure. Furthermore, the operation of such vehicles inside any college building is prohibited.
2. Vehicles covered in this procedure shall be operated in such a manner that does not endanger pedestrians or impede traffic flow.
 - 2.1. Acrobatics, grinding, and related trick riding are prohibited in the interest of safety of the rider.
3. The college speed limit of no greater than 15 MPH shall apply to the use of such vehicles. Vehicles must be operated consistent with applicable provisions of Arizona Revised Statute 15-1449 and campus traffic regulations.
 - 3.1. Bicycles shall be secured to bicycle racks and not to light poles, fences, etc.
 - 3.2. Bicycles found to be in violation of this regulation may be impounded by campus police. Arizona Western College or its agents shall not be liable for damage to individual locking devices during the enforcement of this procedure.
4. Hoverboards and other self-propelled motorized conveyances are prohibited from being inside or stored in any building or structure.
5. Violations of this procedure may be addressed through AWC conduct or the Yuma Municipal Court.
6. Nothing in this procedure restricts the use of ADA-accessibility-related equipment on AWC campus property.
