

Memo of Understanding

As an applicant for the Arizona Western College Paramedic-EMT Academy Open Enrollment Program, I understand that all expenses involving the drug screen testing, and immunization are my responsibility.

I further understand that if the Academy Director receives information during the process that would indicate difficulty in being hired by any agency, the process will be halted and my application rejected. I understand I will be notified that the process has been halted and monies for services rendered will **not** be refunded after the drop and add date.

As the sponsor of the open enrollment cadets, the college has the right to terminate the relationship anytime information concerning the unsuitability of a cadet to become an Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic is received. At that point, the cadet would be notified of the decision and the type of information received. Any refunds will be given according to the standard Arizona Western College refund policy found in the general catalog. This decision may be appealed to the Dean of Instructional Services.
