

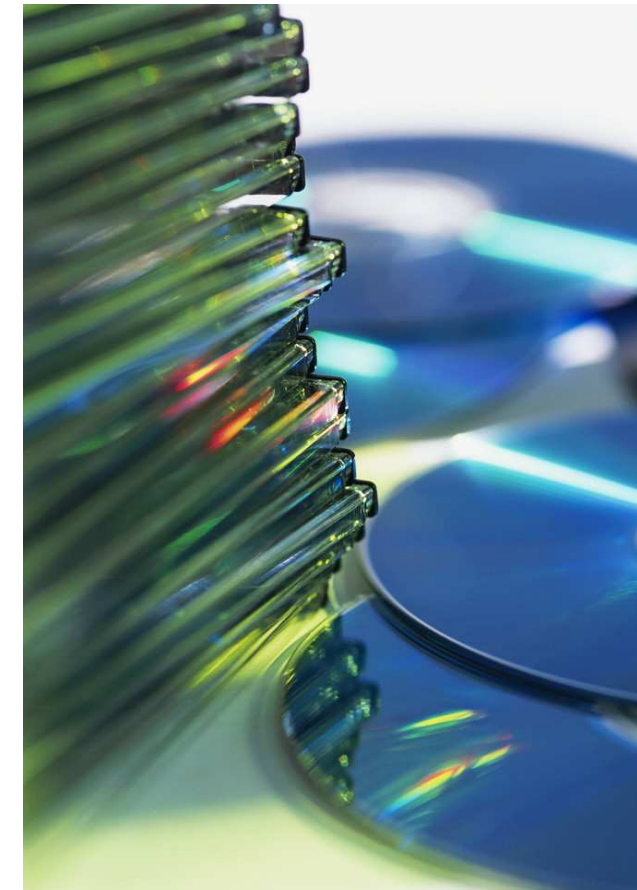
Career Pathway




