A. Bob Walker, VP Technology: Technology Updates:

1. The Respondus Lockdown Browser has been integrated into Blackboard to allow instructors to administer secure on-line testing. An e-mail introduction to the system was sent to faculty on April 8.
2. A second surge of computer replacement will begin with the new fiscal year on July 1st. Please let Bob know about equipment problems and he'll get on it.
3. Outdoor wi-fi is available on main campus for students who do not have home connections. Outdoor wi-fi will soon be coming to the San Luis and Parker campuses as well.

B. Old Business:

1. Faculty Salary: President Corr will make his salary proposal to the DGB on Monday, April 13, at which point a 30-day comment period will begin. The Faculty Senate is on record as opposing the proposal, largely because of the lack of longevity recognition in the salary scale.
2. VPLS Search: Candidate forums and meeting opportunities are taking place during the week of April 6. A selection is anticipated in mid-April.
3. 2020-21 Senate Officers: Matthew Smith was elected president, Joann Chang vice-president, and Colton Kempton will be the representative to the DGB. They will assume office with the May, 2020 meeting.

C. New Business:

1. Constitution update for new meeting time/date: The decision on a meeting time and day for the Senate was tabled until May, pending resolution of questions about the Agility Committee's calendar recommendations.

2. DGB presentation topics: Senators should encourage faculty in each division to use the VPLS Report to brag about their activities, in order to get fresh presentations to the DGB. Information on faculty activities should come through the Faculty Senate.
