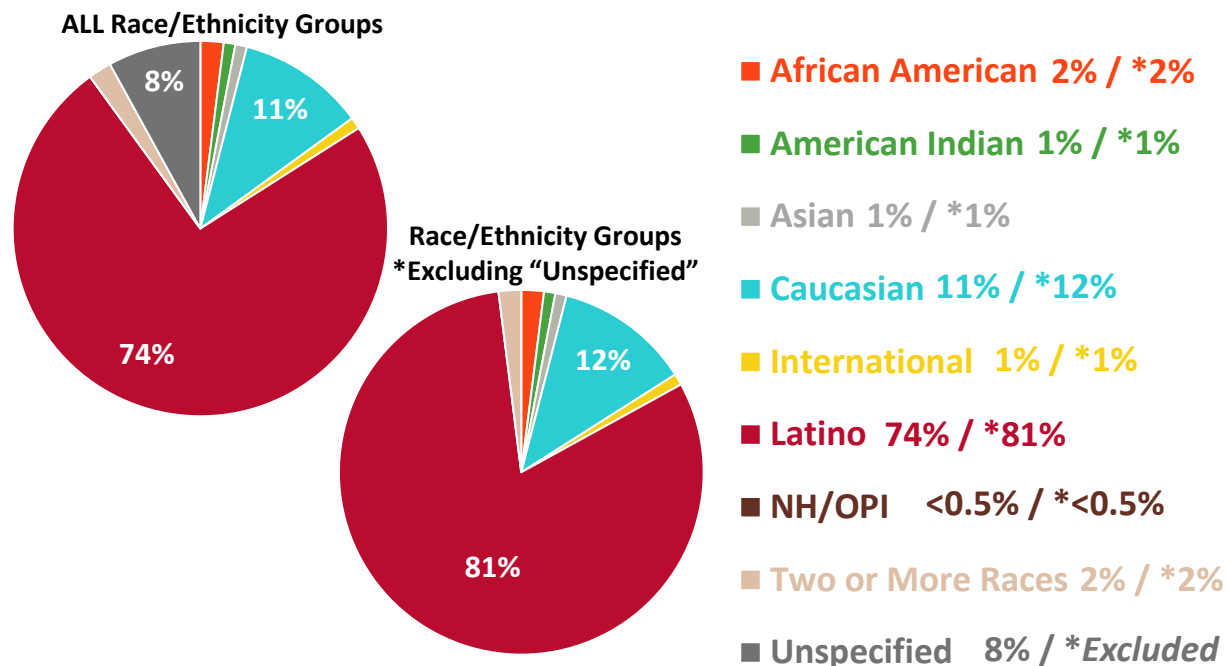

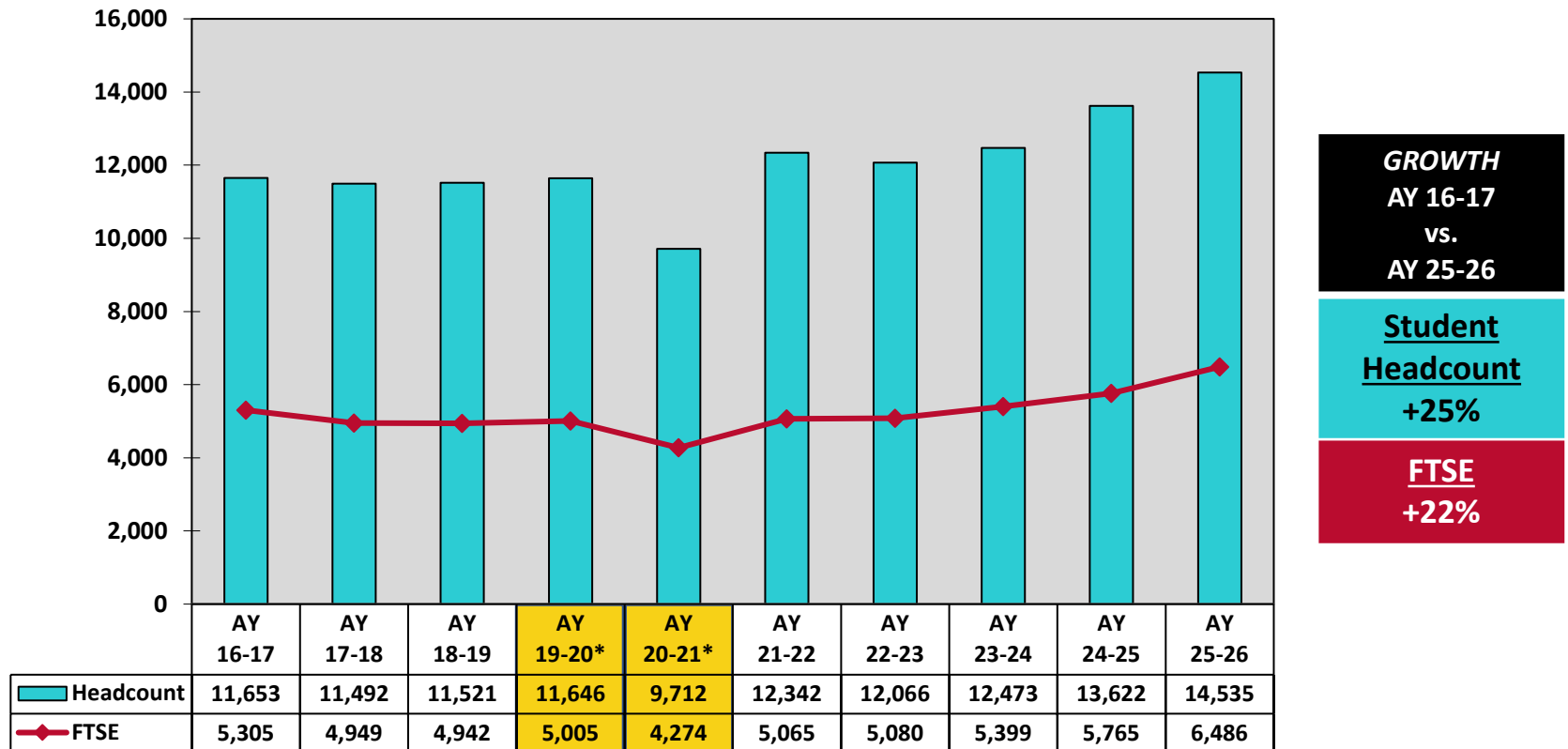

10-Year Trend of Student Headcount & FTSE



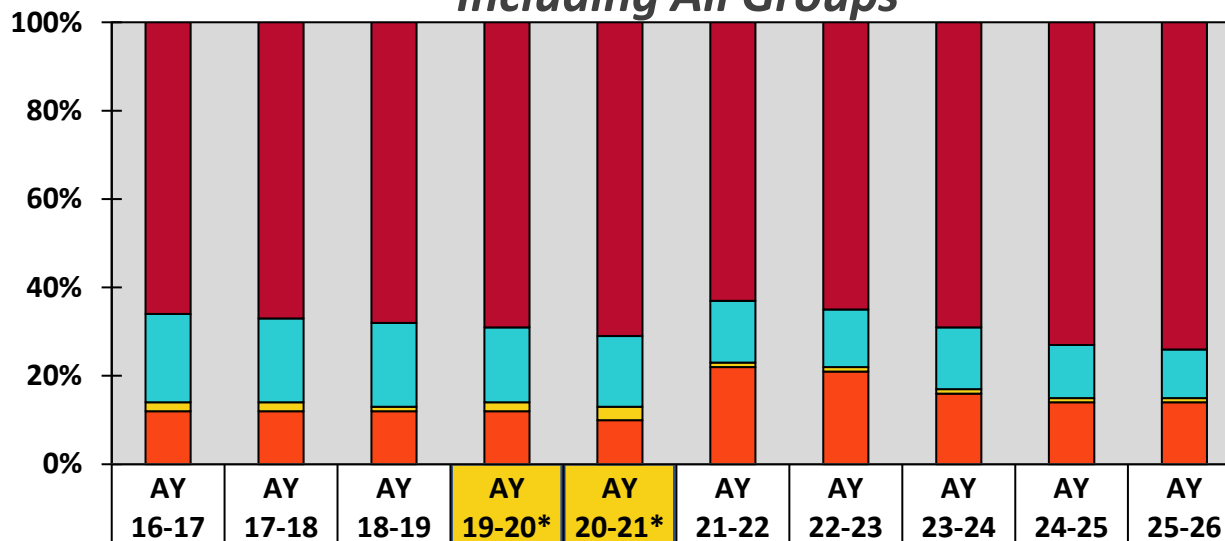

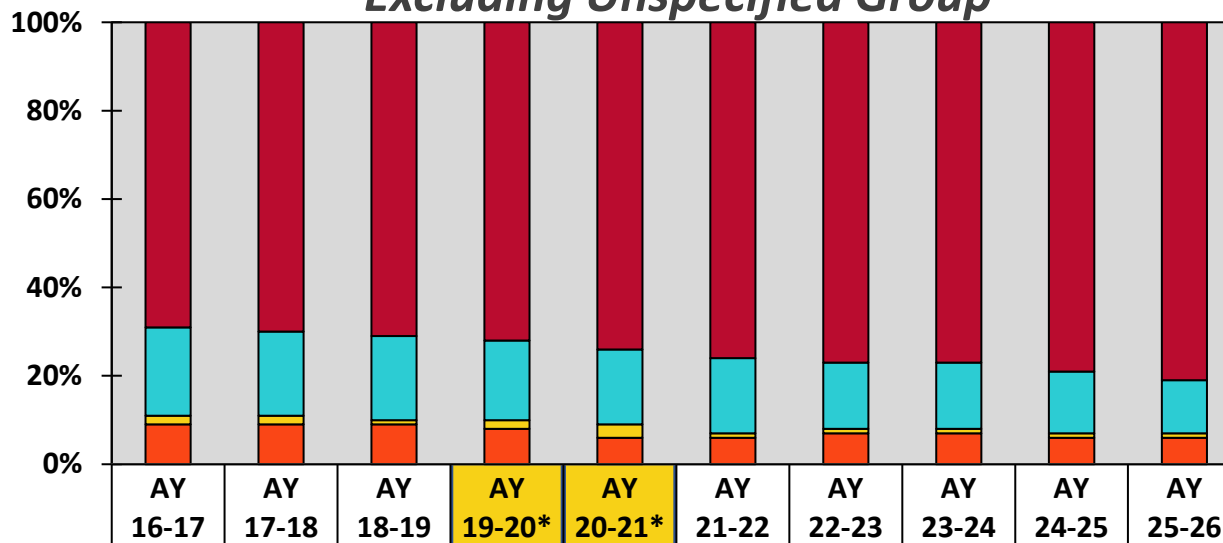

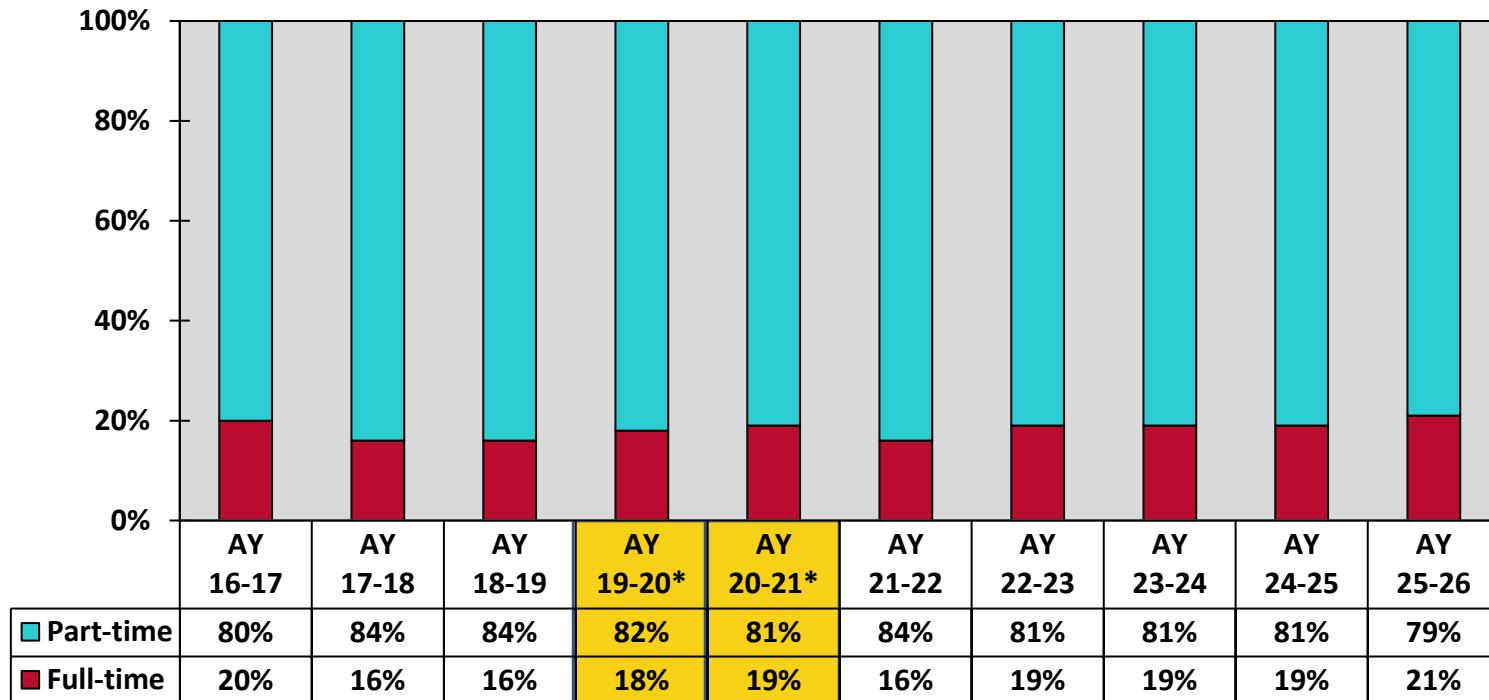

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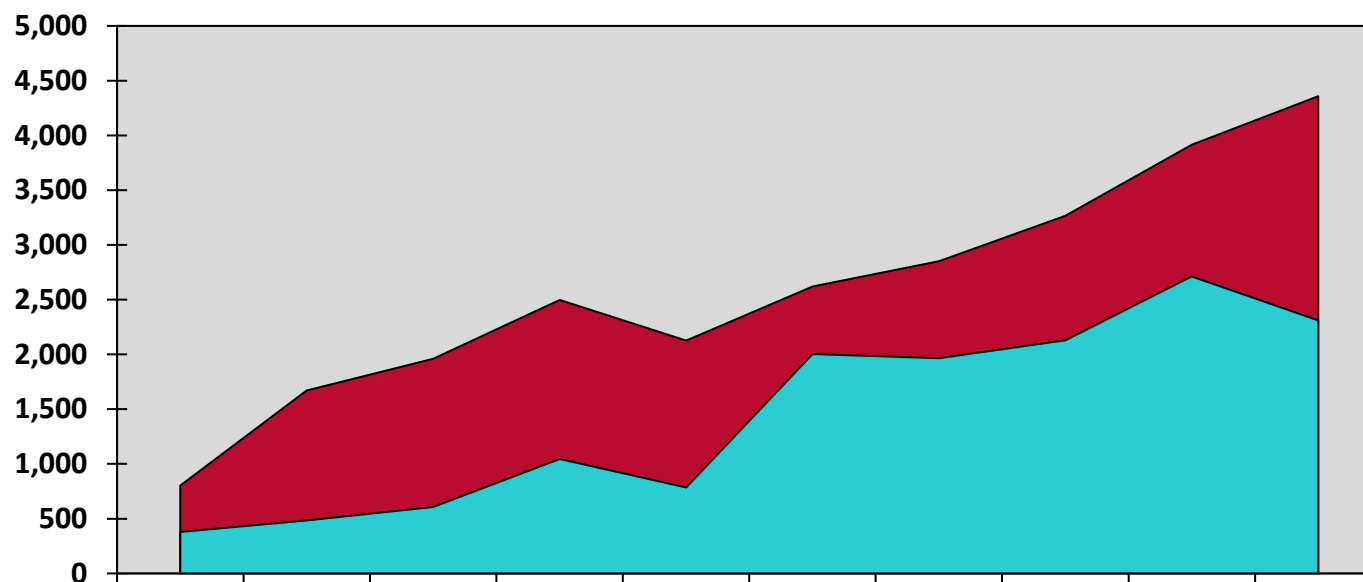
10-Year Trend of Student Headcount by Enrollment Status

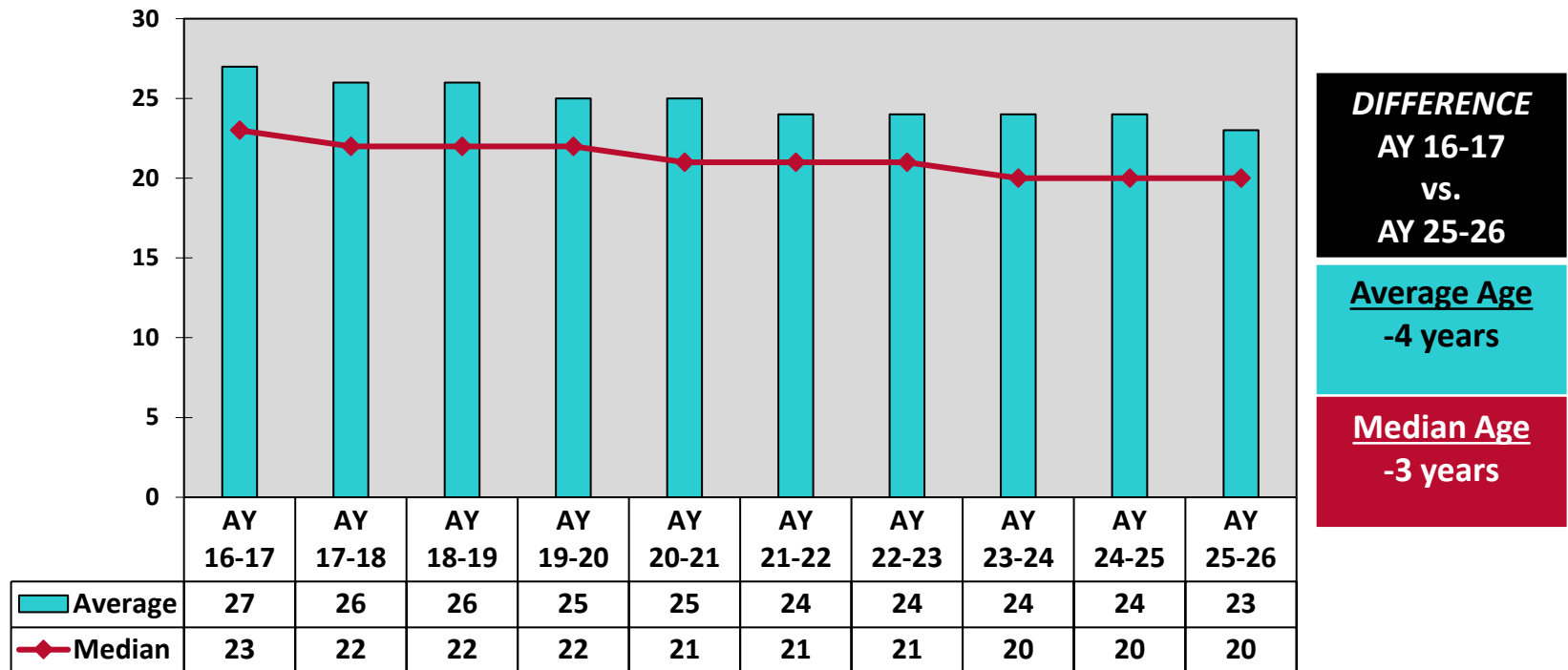

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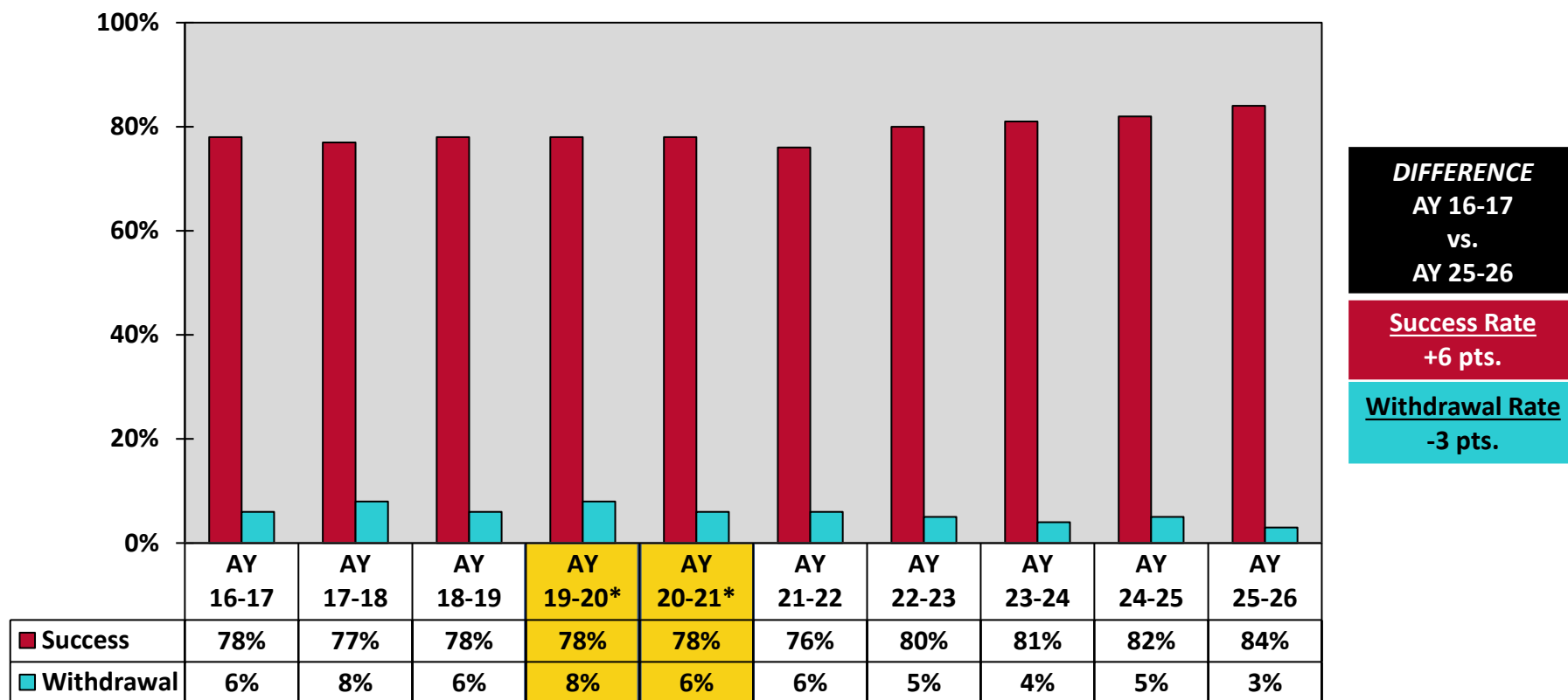

10-Year Trend of Academic Success & Withdrawal Rates

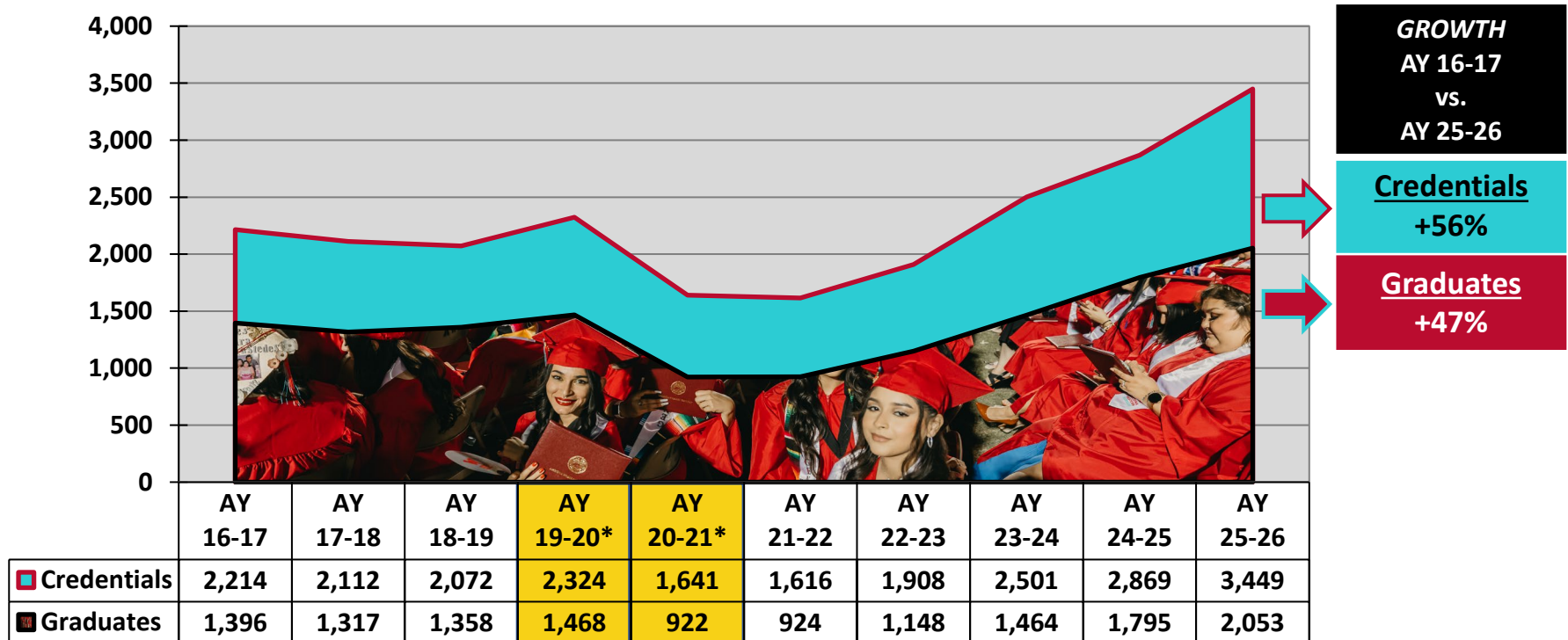


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10-Year Trend of Graduates & Credentials Awarded

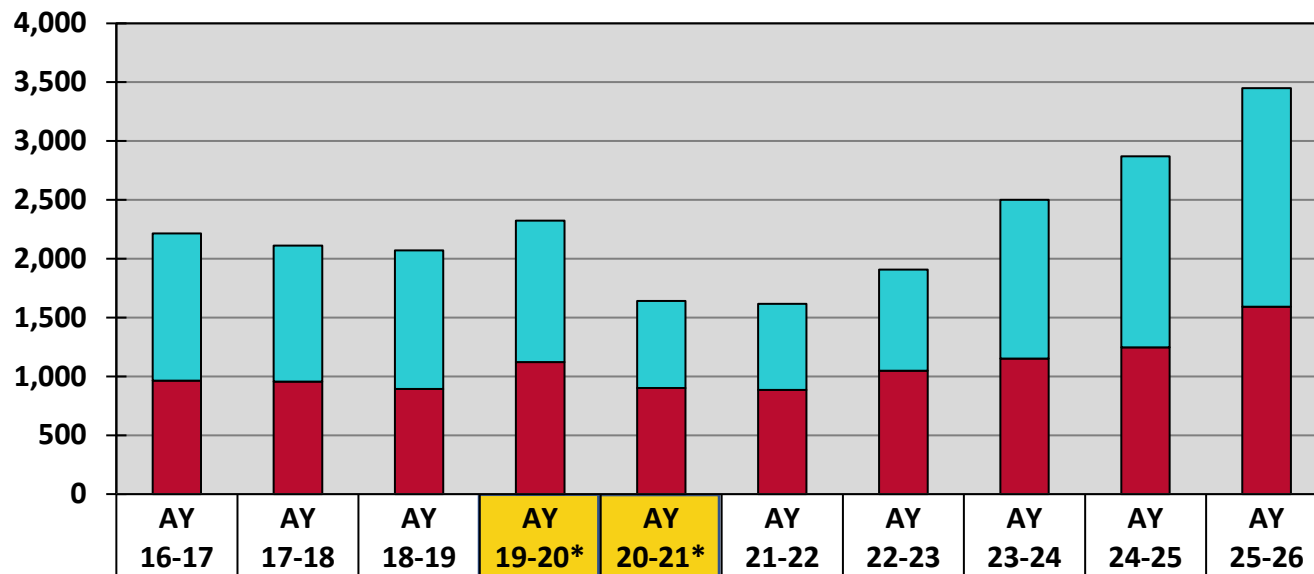
