

How to Apply to AWC as an International Student

1. Go to AWC Website. Link here: <https://www.azwestern.edu/international>
2. **International Student Acceptance Process**
3. [Apply to Arizona Western College](#)
4. [Student Profile / International Admissions Application](#)
5. **Click Create Account, under "Sign In"**
6. Type in First Name, Last Name, Email Address, Confirm Email Address, and Birth Date.
7. Click on the drop down under Gender and select one of the following:
 - Add another gender
 - Female (femenino)
 - Male (masculino)
 - Nonbinary

If you click add another gender, you must type in the gender that applies to you
8. Type in **Mobile Phone**, and **Home Phone**
It will not allow you to enter your country code. Leave this blank, you will have a chance to add the full number later.
9. Answer the question:
Do you agree to receive text messages?
Click the dropdown arrow and select one of the following:
 - Do not allow
 - Allow
10. Check the box that says "Check if address is outside of U.S or Canada"
11. Type in your **Foreign Address** twice
12. Click the **Country** dropdown and select your country.
13. Answer this question below, Click the bubble next to **Yes** or **No**
Did you receive a GED?
A GED (General Educational Development) certificate is a high school equivalency certificate, NOT a high school diploma. Respond "no" if you received or plan to receive a high school diploma.
14. Click **+ Add High School Information**
15. Type in at least the first 3 letters of your high school and click the school you went to
16. If you do not find you school, click delete High School Information
17. If you were homeschooled, click on the box next to "**Were you home schooled for high school?**"
18. Click the dropdown under "**Have you graduated?**" and select **Yes** or **No**
19. Type in the **Year of High School Graduation**
20. Under **Academic Interests**
21. "**What type of student will you be when you enroll?**", click on the first dropdown and select INTERNATIONAL

HIGH SCHOOL (Dual Enrolled) - Students who are currently in high school enrolling in AWC classes offered AT a local high school

INTERNATIONAL - Non-US students intending to study on a student visa

NEW NON-TRADITIONAL - Students age 24 and above with no prior college coursework (not including high school dual enrollment)

NEW TRADITIONAL - Students up to age 23 with no prior college coursework (not including high school dual enrollment)

RETURNING* - Students who have previously attended AWC (not including high school dual enrollment)

*If you have been absent from AWC for less than 12 months, you DO NOT need to re-apply for admission.

TRANSFER - Students with prior college coursework (other than AWC) transferring credits to AWC

22. Click the dropdown under “Anticipated Entry Term”, and select one of the following:
 - Fall 2024
 - Spring 2025
 - Summer 2025
 - Fall 2025
 - Winter 2026
23. Click the dropdown under “Academic Program of Interest” and select the degree you would like to pursue.
24. Answer Verification question, type in your answer.
25. Create a password. Be sure to include the following:
 - 1 upper case letter
 - 1 lower case letter
 - 1 number
 - 1 special character
26. Retype the password you created in previous block
27. Click I’m not a robot
28. Click **Create Account**
29. Once you have created the account. Log back into your account.
30. Under **My Applications**, you should see the [name of the of the degree you are interested](#). Under the name click [Edit](#)

 - American Indian or Alaska Native**
 - Asian**
 - Black or African American**
 - Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander**
 - White**
