

OPEN ACADEMY PARAMEDIC APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Please note: Applications will not be accepted without all of the below information included with the application.

- FYI 1. Thoroughly read the Arizona Western College EMT-PARAMEDIC ACADEMY Guide– Pay careful attention to the Standards for Open Enrollment.
- ___ 2. Complete and submit the Academy Application. (attached)
- ___ 3. Read, complete and submit the Memo of Understanding Form and the Assumption of Risks and Hold Harmless Form. (attached)
- ___ 4. Complete and return the Statement of Personal History and Application for Open Enrollment. (attached form PHFA)
- ___ 5. Complete and return the Medical History Questionnaire. (attached form MH)
- ___ 6. ENG 101 (unofficial or official) transcripts or equivalent placement testing. You must test into ENG 101 to be eligible for this program or have 85+ on the reading placement. This test is offered at the Campus Testing Center in the 3C Building, Monday through Thursday from 0700 to 1700. Please allow 2 hours for this test.
- ___ 7. Applicant must submit the following Lab tests/immunization documents to the Academy:
 - Either: Documentation of 2 MMR vaccines OR a rubella AND rubeola titer showing immunity
 - Either: Documentation of 2 varicella vaccines OR a varicella titer showing immunity
 - Submit drug results to the Academy. This test can be taken at any doctor's office or an Urgent Care facility. The results **MUST** be faxed (317-6230) to the PSI office. Hand delivered results will **NOT** be accepted.
- ___ 8. Submit proof of citizenship (birth certificate, etc.) and a copy of your High School Diploma or GED, and a **copy of a picture ID.**
- ___ 9. **Submit copy of current NREMT Basic Certification.**
- ___ 10. Applicant must have Tb skin test taken 90 days prior to the first day of class (must be submitted with the application). Positive TB test will require a chest x-ray. The Applicant must also begin the Hepatitis B series. Additional immunization might be required.
- ___ 11. Must have completed BIO 160 or BIO 201 & 202
- ___ 12. Copy of your CPR Card
- FYI 13. ADA requirements must be submitted in writing to the Program Director via the appropriate AWC office for the accommodation of a disability. This must be done prior to acceptance into the academy. The physical, mental and emotional standards for completion prohibit most ADA accommodations.
- FYI 14. Once application packet has been reviewed, you will be scheduled for an interview.

The applicant is responsible for all costs that may be involved in the application process.
