

Investigation
106.45(b)(5)

Review any evidence “directly related to the allegations,” including the evidence upon which the recipient does not intend to rely in reaching a determination regarding responsibility and inculpatory or exculpatory evidence whether obtained from a party or other source - 106.45(b)(5)(vi)

1st 10-day Review

Prior to completion of the investigative report, the recipient must send to each party...the evidence subject to inspection and review [this refers to the evidence in the green section above]...and the parties must have at least 10 days to submit a written response, which the investigator will consider prior to completion of the investigative report - 106.45(b)(5)(vi)

2nd 10-day Review

Create an investigative report that fairly summarizes relevant evidence and, at least 10 days prior to a hearing...or other time of determination regarding responsibility, send to each party...the investigative report...for their review and written response – 106.45(b)(5)(vii)

**Both review periods
apply to ALL
Parties**
