## **Orchestra Workshop Classes**

#### Orchestra Level I (A) ...... Thursday 5:30pm-6:45pm ...... Jan 19th – May 11th

This class is for brand new students who must be in 3th grade or 8 years of age through adults. Students are instructed on correct musical terms and parts of their instrument, proper posture, site reading, beginning musical notation and rhythms, ensemble participation, and given the opportunity to perform showing their new skills. If a student does not meet the age requirements, an interview will be required.

Orchestra Level I (B) ...... Jan 19th - May 11th

This class is for continuing students who must be in 3th grade or 8 years of age through adults. Students are instructed on correct musical terms and parts of their instrument, proper posture, site reading, beginning musical notation and rhythms, ensemble participation, and given the opportunity to perform showing their new skills. If a student does not meet the age requirements, an interview will be required. Please note Level I (B) does not take brand new students for the Spring semester, however if you are interested in more educational string opportunities call (928) 487-1344.

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This level III class is for students who will be instructed on even more advanced skills with their instrument, including scales, arpeggios, styles of music and theory. Students will be accepted on the recommendation of the level II and/or III teacher or by audition.
