

Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program Admission Information

Spring Application Opens: July 1
Spring Application Deadline: September 10

Fall Application Opens: February 1
Fall Application Deadline: March 25

- The BSN application for the traditional program or compressed program can be found online at nau.edu/nursing, prior to completing an online nursing application you must **first apply to NAU**, a NAU student id number is required to apply to the program.
- The College of Nursing currently offers the traditional BSN pathway, 2 years (4 semesters with summer off) and the compressed BSN pathway, 16 consecutive months (4 semesters, no summer break). The admission criteria and application process are the same for both programs.
- Must have a minimum *prerequisite* grade point average of a 3.0 to apply.
- All prerequisite courses must be completed by the start of the program but up to 5 can be “in progress” when applying. This includes General Studies courses (see below) which can be fulfilled by obtaining an AGECE from an Arizona Community College.
- Students must meet all NAU course requirements for graduation, these are to be completed prior to starting the BSN program; meet with an NAU advisor for more information.
- HESI Admission Assessment (A2) Exam. The exam results will be used as part of the process of screening and ranking applicants. *You must submit an online nursing application, and have it reviewed before you can take the HESI (A2) Exam.*
