PURPOSE

To regulate the presence of pets on district wide College property.

PROCEDURE

1. Definition

A pet is any animal kept for amusement or companionship. Seeing-eye and Helper Animals are not considered pets.

- 2. No pets are permitted inside district wide buildings at any time, with the exception of Seeing-eye and Helper Animals.
- 3. No pets are to be housed on the campus at any time; however, exceptions may be made for employees required to live on campus with the President's approval.
- 4. Any pet on College property must be restrained by a leash (no longer than 6 feet in length) or secured in a vehicle, cage or appropriate enclosure. Pets may be unleashed at authorized functions with the approval of Risk Management.
- 5. Anyone who has custody of a pet on College property is required to pick up and properly dispose of the pet's waste. Individuals utilizing Seeing-eye and Helper Animals are exempt from this requirement.
- 6. Any city ordinance, county regulation or state statute dealing with animal safety will be enforced.
