Students learn to be proficient in public performances on the Violin, Viola, Cello or Bass. All classes held at Cibola High School 4100 W 20th Street Yuma, AZ 85364. *(please enter at 18<sup>th</sup> St. and go to the Fine Arts building)*

**\*Parents:** You will be required to attend the first 10 minutes of the first class of the semester. We will hand out the syllabus for each level and give you the information about the performing concerts of the semester. After 3 absences student will be removed from the roster. Practice and class participation are very important for maximum learning.

#### **Twinklers** ..... Tuesday 4:30pm-5:30pm ..... Jan 15 – May 7

This is an introductory class, suggested but not limited to 7 through 9 years of age. To be fair, students must be able to function and learn independently. **Parents, or another adult, must attend all classes with their student to participate.** Students are instructed on correct musical terms, parts of their instrument, proper posture, ear training, memorization of beginning musical notation, rhythms, ensemble participation, and will be performing for the community frequently. **ONLY AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE FALL TWINKLERS PROGRAM.**

#### **Young String Ambassadors** ..... Tuesday 5:45pm-6:45pm ..... Jan 15 – May 7

This class is a continuation of the Twinklers course. It is suggested but not limited to 7 through 13 years of age. Students are instructed on more advanced musical skills, reading music, and will be performing for the community frequently. Students will be accepted on the recommendation of the teacher or by audition.

#### **Beginning Orchestra (Part A)** ..... Thursday 5:30pm-6:45pm ..... Jan 17 – May 9

This class is for new students who must be in 4th grade or 9 years of age through adults. Students are instructed on correct musical terms and parts of their instrument, proper posture, beginning musical notation and rhythms, theory, ensemble participation, and given the opportunity to perform showing their new skills. If a student does not meet the age requirements, an audition will be required. **STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE BEGINNING ORCHESTRA (PART A) IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN PART B IN THE SPRING.**

#### **Intermediate Orchestra** ..... Thursday 5:30pm-6:45pm ..... Jan 17 – May 9

This class is for students who **must** be reading music. Students will be instructed on more advanced skills with their instrument including scales, arpeggios, styles of music, and theory. Participants will be playing in ensemble, introduced to position work, and be given the opportunity to perform showing their new skills. Students will be accepted on the recommendation of the Beginning Orchestra teacher, a private teacher, or by audition.

#### **Refund/Cancellation Policy**

A 100% refund is granted or another individual may attend in your place if a request is made two working days prior to the start of class. A 50% refund will be issued if notice is received less than two working days prior to class start date. No refunds will be issued after the first day of class.
