

Application Process - Radiologic Technology

1. Read the current Student Guide and view the video(s) about the profession below.

2. Earn a Next Generation Reading score of 237 or higher and complete all Prerequisite Courses with a 2.50 or higher by the fall semester prior to the application period.
3. Submit transcripts for evaluation for courses not taken at AWC.
 1. A Request for Evaluation/Re-Evaluation of Credits must be submitted along with an official (sealed) transcript. Please contact Transfer Services by phone (928) 344-7638 or visit them in the 3C Building on Main Campus, or by mail: Arizona Western College, Attn: Transfer Services Office, PO Box 929, Yuma, AZ 85366.
 2. An Application for Admission must be completed if (a) You are a new student to Arizona Western College or (b) You are a former AWC student and have not taken classes in the past 12 months. There is a separate application form that is required to apply for the Radiologic Technology Program (See #5 below).
4. Order a Fingerprint Clearance Card (If you do not have a current* card, order Fall semester prior to applying).
 1. If you have a valid Fingerprint Clearance Card, a copy of the card must be submitted along with a completed Program application.
 2. If you do not have a Fingerprint Clearance Card, you will have to apply for one.
 - Order online at [Fieldprint®](#). A fee is collected at time of order.

- Be advised that it can take anywhere from 4 – 8 weeks to receive your card from The Department of Public Safety. We will NOT accept Program applications without the card.

*** A current card is one that will not expire before the end of the 2-year Program enrollment period**

5. Submit a completed Program application to the Radiologic Technology Office.
 1. Program applications are available on the Radiology Technology webpage. Applications will be available mid-January to the last Thursday in February.
 2. Next Generation Reading score, unofficial transcripts, and a valid Fingerprint Clearance Card must be submitted with Program application.
 - Next Generation Reading score must be obtained from the Testing Services Office.
 - Unofficial transcripts must be obtained from the Admissions and Registration Office; printouts from Web Advisor will NOT be accepted.
6. Upon verification of acceptable prerequisite GPA and Next Generation reading score, the radiology program will issue qualified students a testing permit for the ATI TEAS exam. ATI TEAS scores must be turned in to the Radiologic Technology office (LR 224) by March 9th, no exceptions will be made.
7. Students that receive a 50% or better on the ATI TEAS exam will be asked to give a presentation to Program Faculty and Staff. Presentations will be scheduled by the Radiologic Technology Office in March.
8. Student Selection Process. Notifications of acceptance or declination will be emailed by the Radiologic Technology Office in April.
